## **VISITING TEAMS**

<u>Policies & Procedures</u> will be mandatory for all skaters and their families at the NCWC as of Nov. 1, 2020.

## **GENERAL NCWC COVID PROTOCOLS:**

- Anyone exhibiting COVID symptoms will not be allowed on the premises. All skaters and families must comply with the CT Sector Rules including but not limited to any travel to "red states."
- Limit <u>one family member</u> per player to attend games.
- Required all players should arrive partially or fully dressed no more than 15 minutes prior to game time.
- Each visiting team will be assigned a designated outdoor "locker room" (with benches) for skate tying, stick & bag storage. If there are weather elements, indoor locker rooms will be made available.
- Access to "locker rooms" will ONLY be allowed 15 minutes prior to game time. Teams must vacate premises 15 minutes after completion of game.
- Players are required to wear a mask while dressing in the designated outdoor locker room.
- Visiting teams will use designated rink entrances near assigned outdoor locker rooms.
- For all spectators, a mask is required when six feet distancing is not possible.

## **CLUBHOUSE:**

- Clubhouse is for member-use only, in a *limited* capacity.
- Visitors may use the restrooms, if needed.
- A facial mask is MANDATORY FOR ADULTS and CHILDREN IN THE CLUBHOUSE.
- No food or drink allowed in the clubhouse.
- Bring individual water-bottles. Water fountain inside is not available.

## **PARKING:**

 Access to the NCWC parking lot will be limited -- All visiting teams should park in the New Canaan Country School driveway and parking lot located directly across the street from the NCWC entrance.
No parking on Frogtown Road.
